

Unique Porsche Models in the Heart of Warsaw – Air|Water Poland 2025 This Saturday!

This coming weekend, Warsaw will become the capital of automotive beauty and engineering excellence. It's here that Air|Water Poland will take place – the first European edition of the iconic event created by Patrick Long and Jeff Zwart, which merges design artistry, racing history, and uncompromising passion for the Porsche brand.

Over 250 exceptional Porsche models will be showcased at the Nocny Market and Stacja Muzeum venues – including cars rarely seen in such a setting anywhere else. The true stars of the show will be legendary vehicles directly from the Porsche collection and the Porsche Museum.

Among them: the Porsche 918 RSR Studie, a vision of the future of racing unveiled in 2011 in Detroit. This hybrid model, based on the Porsche 918 Spyder, was built for the track. It combines a powerful V8 combustion engine with two electric motors, jointly delivering an impressive 767 horsepower. Instead of batteries, it features an innovative energy recovery system derived from Porsche's experience with the 911 GT3 R Hybrid. This visionary machine became a symbol of Porsche's bold technological ambitions and a precursor to its hybrid triumphs – including the 24h Le Mans win in 2015.

Two Generations of Hill Climb Kings

Visitors will also see one of the most extreme Porsche concept cars ever built – the Boxster Bergspyder, a radical, lightweight, one-seat roadster without a roof or windshield, constructed in 2015 on the basis of the 981-generation Boxster. Weighing just 1130 kg and powered by the Cayman GT4 engine with 393 hp, it offers a stunning power-to-weight ratio of 2.88 kg/hp.

Its spiritual predecessor, the legendary Porsche 909 Bergspyder from 1968, is the lightest race car Porsche has ever built – only 384 kg, with a fiberglass body, aluminum frame, and titanium springs. Designed for hill climb races, it packed 275 hp and could accelerate to 100 km/h in just 2.4 seconds. Only two were ever made – and one will be on display in Warsaw.

Modern Legends

The event will also feature modern racing beauty. Among the showcased models will be the Porsche 911 GT3 R Rennsport, a 77-unit limited edition that pays tribute to Porsche's racing heritage and embodies the performance of the GT3 without compromise. The model debuted at Rennsport Reunion 7 and has since been shown only a few times, including at the last Air|Water in California.

A special guest will be the Porsche Cayenne S Transsyberia – a rally version of the first-generation Cayenne, built for the extreme Transsyberia Rally, which led from Moscow through

Siberia to Ulaanbaatar. In 2007, Porsche entered an official team and achieved great success in the challenging off-road event. One of just 26 competition-spec vehicles will be on view in Warsaw. The Cayenne S Transsyberia featured a safety cage, raised suspension, special exhaust system, snorkel, reinforced underbody protection, and distinctive livery. A customer version was later released as a limited 600-unit run. It's a true SUV with off-road capability and purebred sports DNA.

Privately Owned Gems

Air|Water Poland will also host exceptional cars from private collections. Among the 250+ models will be classics with rich history and modern, bespoke configurations – vehicles rarely seen outside their owners' garages. Visitors will be able to admire them up close at the Porsche Centrum Warszawa Okęcie and Porsche Centrum Warszawa booths. It's a one-of-a-kind opportunity to experience the diversity of the Porsche world through the eyes of its most dedicated enthusiasts.

A Photography Celebration

Air|Water Poland is more than just an exhibition – it's a celebration of automotive photography. The event space will include themed zones and booths from Porsche community partners. The industrial atmosphere of Warsaw's Nocny Market and Stacja Muzeum will provide the perfect backdrop for an emotionally charged display of memories, innovation, and technical artistry.

The event is organized by VMR, an agency specializing in projects for luxury automotive brands, which also produced last year's Luftgekühlt Poland. Partners of the Polish edition of Air|Water include: Porsche Poland, Porsche Centrum Warszawa Okęcie, Porsche Centrum Warszawa, Porsche Store Warszawa, and PRM concept.
